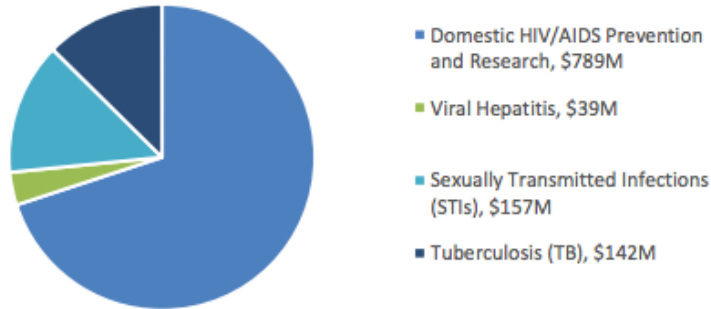

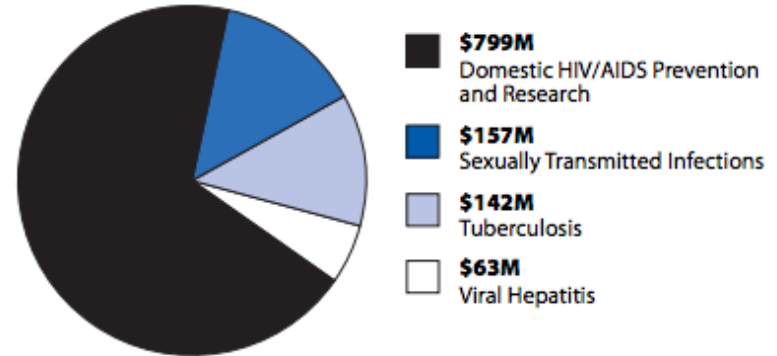
CDC President’s Budget Requests FY 2017 & FY 2016

FY 2017 President’s Budget Request



A total of \$1.13 billion requested includes \$5 million above FY 2016 Enacted level.

FY 2016 President’s Budget Request



A total of \$1.162 billion requested is:

- \$44 million above FY 2015 Enacted level

While sexually-transmitted infections are on the rise,

- The CDC’s request for STI prevention funding has remained stagnant.
- The CDC is requesting **\$10 million less** for Domestic HIV/AIDS Prevention & Research for FY 2017 than for FY 2016.
- The overall budget request for HIV/AIDS, Viral Hepatitis, STIs, and Tuberculosis has **decreased by \$30 million**.

Although 2017 Budget Requests are above 2016 Enacted Level, enacted level consistently falls short of requested level.

- For FY 2016, Requested Level: **\$1.162 billion**; Enacted Level: **\$1.122 billion**
- For FY 2015, Requested Level: **\$1.128 billion**; Enacted Level: **\$1.118 billion**
- For FY 2014, Requested Level: **\$1.177 billion**; Enacted Level: **\$1.120 billion**
