Under its **Positive Healthcare** brand, AHF operates managed care programs for people living with HIV and/or AIDS in California and Florida. Link: <http://positivehealthcare.net> Total Current Positive Healthcare Client Enrollment is **4,467 clients**, with Roster Numbers broken down as follows:

In California:

- **624 enrollees in PHC California**, a Medi-Cal (Medicaid) managed care plan for people living with AIDS in Los Angeles County.
- **693 enrollees in PHP (HMO SNP)** Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with AIDS in reside in Los Angeles County. .

In Florida:

- **656 enrollees in (Broward) PHC Florida & 953 enrollees (Miami/Dade & Monroe) PHC Florida**, Medicaid managed care plans designed specifically for HIV-positive individuals who are eligible for Medicaid and live in Broward, Miami-Dade and Monroe Counties.
- **1,526 enrollees PHP (HMO SNP)**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV and reside in Broward and Miami-Dade Counties.

In Georgia:

- **15 enrollees in PHP**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV.

AHF Research has over 10 years of experience with anti-retroviral (ARV) studies and is dedicated to discovering better treatments and improving quality of life for people living with HIV. AHF Dental currently operated two full service dental clinics for people living with HIV/AIDS in the US. In Los Angeles, the Downtown AHF Dental Clinic serves a census of **1,227* patients (*as of Feb. 2, '19)**. In South Florida, the AHF Dental Clinic in Ft. Lauderdale currently serves a census of **684 patients. (*as of Feb. 2 '19)**.

January 2019 AHF Facts at a Glance-- Key Highlights:

Month-over-month changes—AHF clients & staff—December 2018 - January 2019:

AHF Clients:

- As of the Jan. 1, 2019 Global Patient Report, AHF now has **1,072,774 total clients in care**.
- This represents a slight **DECREASE** of **214 AHF clients or patients** worldwide, month-to-month (as of the Jan 30, 2019 Global Patient Report, down from 1,072,988 in the last 'Facts' covering December 2018).
- This decline in patient census was in part due to the closure of eight (8) clinics in CAMBODIA.

AHF Staff:

- A net decrease of **31 AHF employee** overall worldwide to **6,497 total AHF employees worldwide**, including:
 - **An INCREASE of 3 U.S. staff**
 - **A DECREASE of 59 global staff**, and
 - **2,349 other AHF-supported staff** in global programs (bucket staff, casuals, etc.), reflecting updated numbers (+25) from AHF Europe.
- This report includes a breakout of the **4,467 clients** enrolled in our various **Positive Healthcare (PHC & PHP)** Medicare and Medicaid managed care programs in **California, Florida and Georgia** (page #2 of "Facts"--PHP = Medicare; PHC = Medicaid).

- **NO** new AHF sites were opened or added in the U.S. in January 2019.

GLOBAL

- AHF's Global program also now operates **584 global AHF clinics**, **ADDING a net gain of one (1) new treatment site in January**. **NOTE: nine (9) sites were added, and eight (8) in Cambodia were closed.**
