Under its **Positive Healthcare** brand, AHF operates managed care programs for people living with HIV and/or AIDS in California and Florida.

Link: <http://positivehealthcare.net> Total Current Positive Healthcare Client Enrollment is **2,861** clients, with Roster Numbers broken down as follows:

In California:

- **615 enrollees in PHC California**, a Medi-Cal (Medicaid) managed care plan for people living with AIDS in Los Angeles County.
- **694 enrollees in PHP (HMO SNP)** Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with AIDS in reside in Los Angeles County.

In Florida:

- **1,527 enrollees PHP (HMO SNP)**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV and reside in Broward and Miami-Dade Counties.

In Georgia:

- **25 enrollees in PHP**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV.

AHF Research has over 10 years of experience with anti-retroviral (ARV) studies and is dedicated to discovering better treatments and improving quality of life for people living with HIV. AHF Dental currently operated two full service dental clinics for people living with HIV/AIDS in the US. In Los Angeles, the Downtown AHF Dental Clinic serves a census of **1,285* patients (*as of 9/28/19)**. In South Florida, the AHF Dental Clinic in Ft. Lauderdale currently serves a census of **580 patients. (*as of 9/28/19)**.

Month-over-month changes—AHF clients & staff— August – September 2019:

AHF Clients:

- As of the September 27, 2019 Global Patient Report, AHF now has **1,307,820 total clients in care**.
- This represents an **INCREASE of 24,610 AHF clients or patients** worldwide, month-to-month (as of the August 30, 2019 Global Patient Report, up from 1,283,210 in the last 'Facts' covering August 2019). This represents an average of **879 new patients per day** in June somewhere in AHF's care around the globe in the 28 days between 'Facts' reports.

AHF Staff:

- A net increase of **15 AHF employee** overall worldwide to **6,632 total AHF employees worldwide**, including:
 - **A DECREASE of 5 U.S. staff**
 - **An INCREASE of 14 global staff**, and
 - **2,354 other AHF-supported staff** in global programs (bucket staff, casuals, etc.)
- This report also includes a breakout of the **2,861 clients** now enrolled in our various **Positive Healthcare** (PHC & PHP) Medicare and Medicaid managed care programs in **California, Florida and Georgia** (page #2 of "Facts"--PHP = Medicare; PHC = Medicaid).
