

MARCH 2021 AHF Facts at a Glance-- Key Highlights:

Month-over-month changes—AHF clients & staff FEBRUARY – MARCH 2021

AHF Clients:

- As of **MARCH 2021**, and with the March 5, 2021 Global Patient Report, AHF now has **1,539,139 clients in care**.
- This figure represents a census INCREASE (up **22,782 AHF clients or patients** worldwide), month-to-month since the March 5, 2020 Global Patient Report.

AHF Staff:

- A net increase of **112 AHF employees** overall worldwide to **6,852 total AHF employees worldwide**, including:
 - **An INCREASE of 7 U.S. staff**
 - **A DECREASE of 2 global staff**, and
 - **2,156 other AHF-supported staff** in global programs (bucket staff, casuals, etc.)
- This report also includes a breakout of the **2,886 clients** now enrolled in our various **Positive Healthcare** (PHC & PHP) Medicare and Medicaid managed care programs in **California, Florida and Georgia** (page #2 of "Facts"--PHP = Medicare; PHC = Medicaid).

US & GLOBAL & PROGRAMS & COUNTRIES:

US

- An AHF Healthcare Center that had a soft open last fall, AHF Lakeview Healthcare Center, in **CHICAGO, ILLINOIS**, was formally dedicated with a ribbon-cutting ceremony on Wednesday, March 31st. In addition, AHF relocated our AHF HCC in **PUERTO RICO** from the municipality of Trujillo Alto in San Juan to the nearby municipality of Carolina. An AHF Pharmacy Access Center opened at the new Carolina site while the AHF Pharmacy in Trujillo Alto remains open until the license transfer to the Carolina site is completed.

GLOBAL

- AHF's Global program now operates **736 global AHF clinics**, ADDING four (4) new treatment sites globally.

Under its **Positive Healthcare** brand, AHF operates managed care programs for people living with HIV and/or AIDS in California and Florida.

In California:

- **695 enrollees in PHC California**, a Medi-Cal (Medicaid) managed care plan for people living with AIDS in Los Angeles County.
- **660 enrollees in PHP (HMO SNP)** Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with AIDS in reside in Los Angeles County.

In Florida:

- **1,503 enrollees PHP (HMO SNP)**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV and reside in Broward and Miami-Dade Counties.

In Georgia:

- **28 enrollees in PHP**, a Medicare Advantage Prescription Drug health plan specifically for Medicare beneficiaries who are living with HIV.

AHF Dental currently operated two full service dental clinics for people living with HIV/AIDS in the US. In Los Angeles, the Downtown AHF Dental Clinic serves a census of **1,339* patients (*as of 3/27/21)**. In South Florida, the AHF Dental Clinic in Ft. Lauderdale currently serves a census of **437 patients. (*as of 3/27/21)**.
