





#### Number of Condoms Distributed by Brand





Performance by Bureau, 2022





Cumulative VMMC Services for Rwanda and Zambia, 2020 - 2022








#### **Global Program Eight-Year HIV Testing Trend**

Number of persons tested and positivity rate (2015 to 2022)





HIV Testing and Positivity Rate by Regional Bureau, 2022





Total persons tested and positivity ratio, by gender and age category, 2022





Positivity rate by main reason for HIV-test, 2022





Positivity ratio by Key and Vulnerable Populations, 2022





Numbers of positive tests by 1st or repeat testers and positivity ratio, 2022




Number of tests and positivity ratio by regional bureaus, 2022




Numbers tested and positivity ratio by test setting, 2022



Numbers tested and positivity ratio by test program category, 2022





Number of Tests and Positivity Rate by Country, 2022





Census growth 2012 – 2022 (Global and US programs combined)




Census growth 2012 – 2022 (Global and US programs combined)



New enrolments by category (Apr-Dec 2022)




New enrolments by category by Bureau (Apr-Dec 2022)



Proportion of sites and median time to ART initiation by bureau, 2022




Benchmark 5: Proportion of clients with a baseline CD4 test by bureau, 2022





Distribution of reasons for becoming NLIC, Q1-Q4 2022




Proportion of LTFU among NLIC and All clients, 2019-2022



Crude, HIV-related and non-HIV-related mortality rate, 8 years trend (2015 – 2022)




Tuberculosis (TB) mortality rate per 1,000 clients, 2015- 2022





Proportion of clients eligible and screened for cervical cancer, 2022






